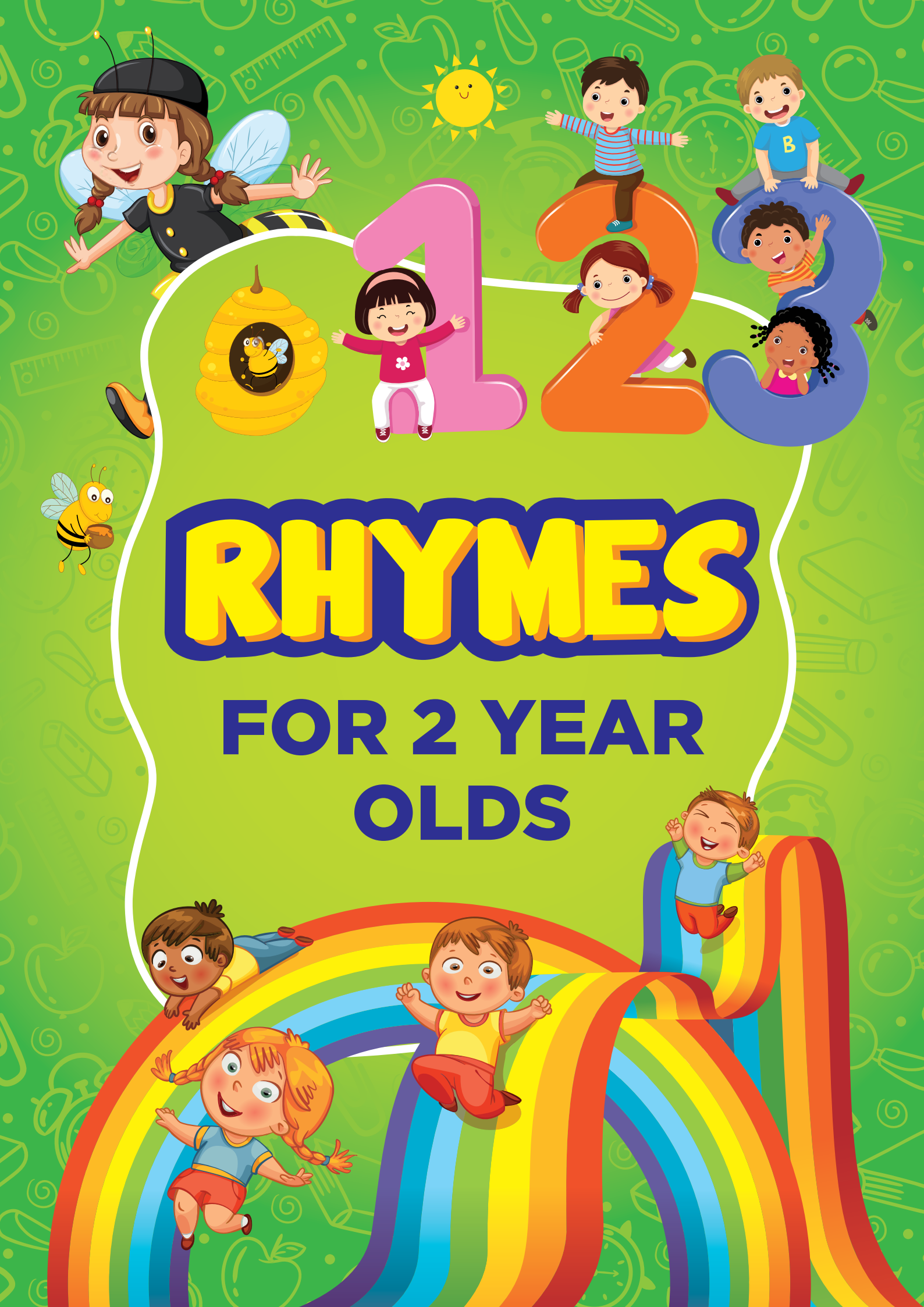

A WISE OLD OWL

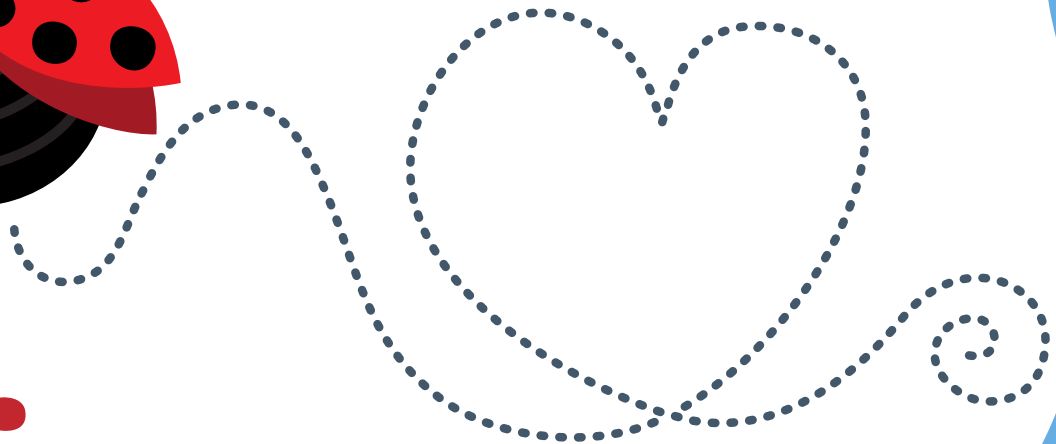
A wise old owl sat in an oak,

INCY WINCY SPIDER

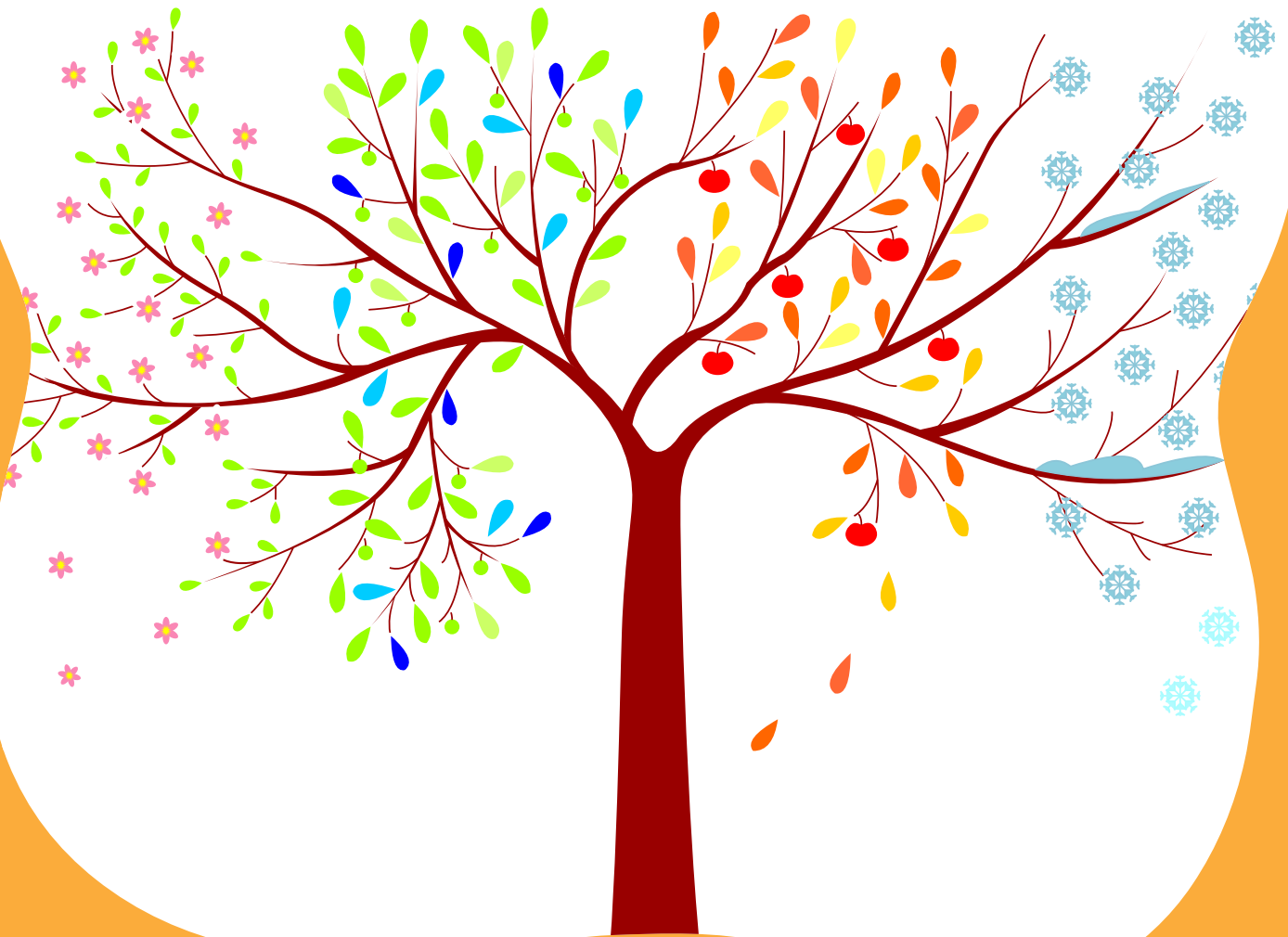
Incy Wincy spider climbed up the water spout,

time to take out coats and furs.



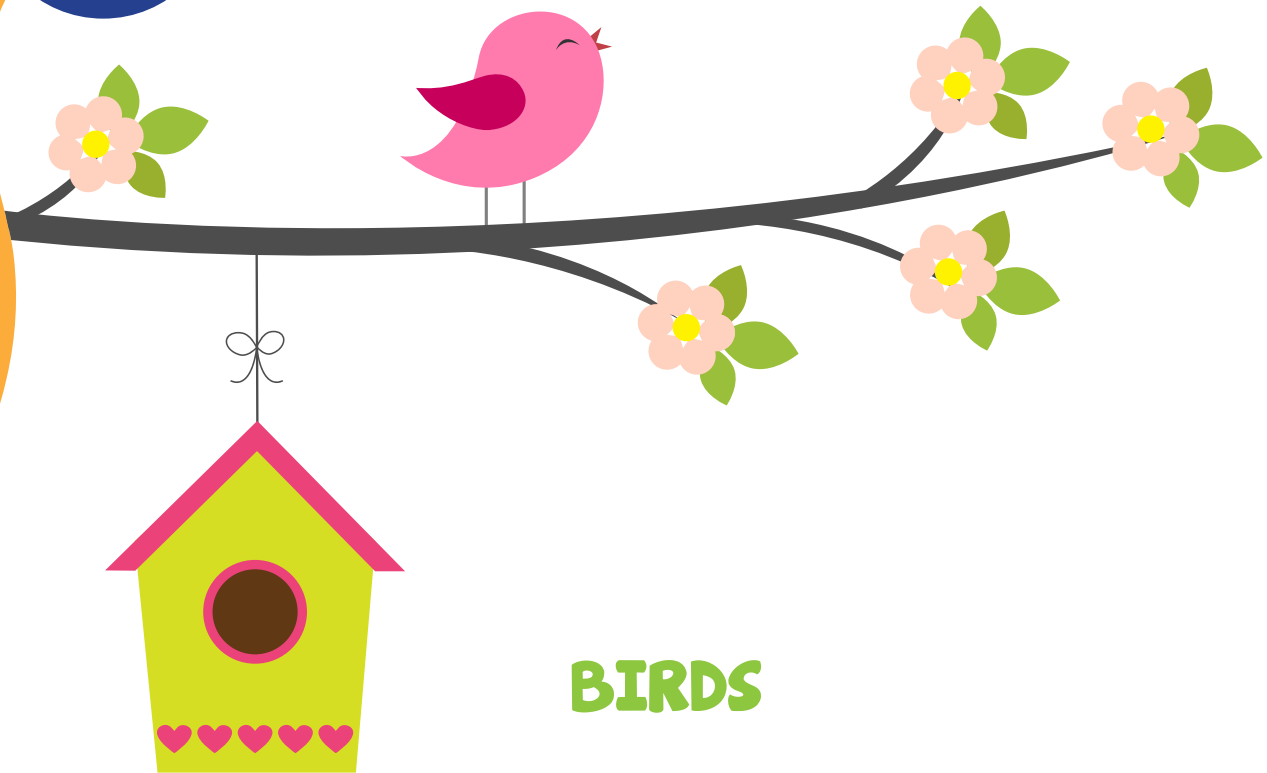
WE SEE LEAVES

RAINBOW SONG

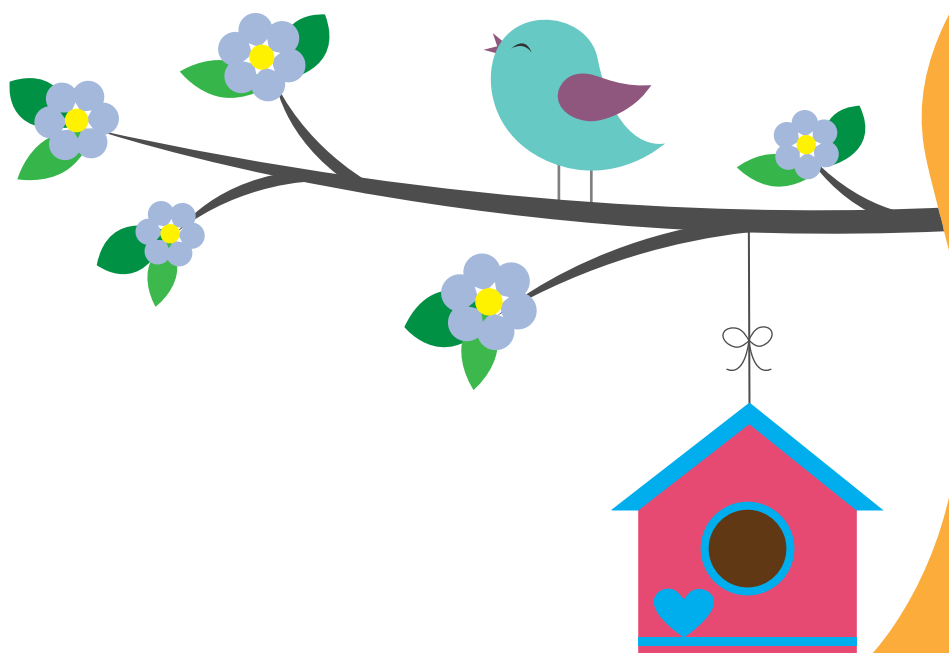
Oh ,Rainbow , Oh , Rainbow

(mime the Dr, wagging finger firmly)

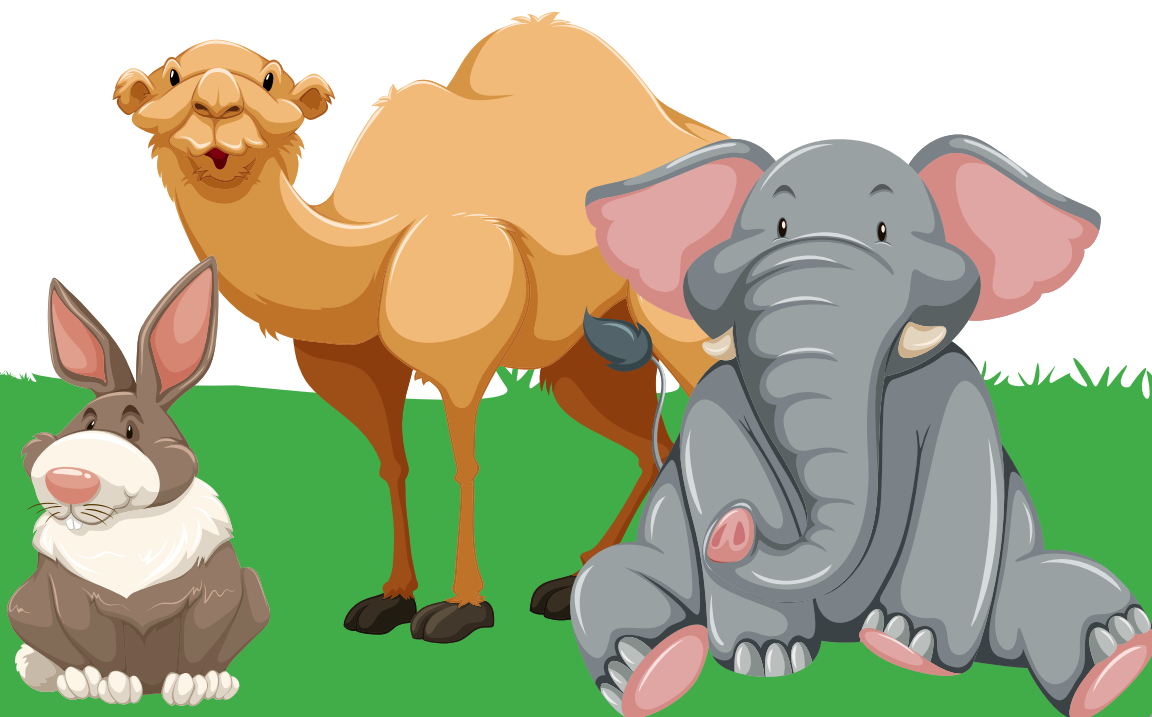
Four little monkeys jumping on the bed, etc.
